EXAM APPLICANTS

Exams at the ICM office will adhere to the safety protocols in place in Manitoba.

- Exam applicants **must** wait in the hallway. Do not enter the ICM office until called upon by an ICM staff member. ICM staff will open the exam room door and call each applicant for registration individually respecting the social distancing protocol.
- Exam applicants **must** not linger in the hallway outside the ICM office doors, and **must** use the refreshment area in the building basement or use the waiting room on the 5th floor (Room 544 open at 7:30am).
- Exam applicants **must** at all times maintain a distance of at least 2 meters (6 feet) from other Exam Applicants, ICM staff or other individuals on the ICM premises.
- Exam applicants **must** bring their own pencil and non-programmable calculator.
- Exam applicants **must** wear a mask at all times while waiting in line at the ICM and during the exam (masks will not be supplied by the ICM, and each applicant must bring their own).
- Exam applicants **must** obey the social distancing guidelines.
- Exam applicants **must** use hand sanitizer immediately before entering the exam room.
- Exam applicants **must** have completed the Manitoba Shared Health COVID-19 Screening Tool: <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/> and will be required to confirm that all of the answers were “no”.

An exam applicant that does not bring the items listed above, or obey the safety protocols, will not be able to write the exam.
