



Notice to all Manitoba Insurance Companies Emailed June 4, 2019

The Insurance Council of Manitoba (“ICM”) licence renewal for 2019/2020 is now complete. Please review the list of licensees on the ICM website under “[Licence Search](#)” for the specific insurance company listed above to ensure all individuals are properly licensed with Council. Any agent/broker who failed to renew their licence is unlicensed effective June 1, 2019, and may not act as an insurance agent/broker or be paid for new business written. The applicable “[application](#)” is required to be completed by the applicant for consideration of reinstatement. Notice of completion of the reinstatement will be provided to the agent by email. ***Any agent/broker who has a gap in licensing history must not act within the definition of an agent during that unlicensed period.***

As a reminder, you are required to notify the ICM immediately when you no longer sponsor an insurance agent/broker [in accordance with Section 373(2) of *The Insurance Act* of Manitoba]. All withdrawals of sponsorship must be submitted in writing to the ICM by using the ICM’s [Termination Form](#).

Agent/broker licensing status is subject to change on a daily basis. You may check an agent/broker licensing status at any time on the ICM website at www.icm.mb.ca under “[Licence Search](#)”.

As a reminder, due to the success of the online portal, paper applications for “amendments” or “transfers” of a currently active licence are no longer accepted as of **June 1, 2019**. These types of applications, along with applications for NEW applicants, must be submitted through the [online portal](#) only.
